REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

\$5 Discount: Students receive discount when registering a minimum of one week prior to start of their session when registering for a full term.

Students are encouraged to pre-register, as a class may be cancelled for insufficient enrollment. Once opened, class registration is received on a first come, first served basis.

Registration Schedule: 3 weeks prior to a new session beginning, priority registration begins for current students. 1 week prior to start of the new session (or once all open spaces have been confirmed), registration will be open to the public and incoming members.

A minimum of 6 weeks must be paid for an 8 week session. If a class is on a waitlist, the full 8 week tuition MUST be paid.

Pottery: If glazing of pieces is not completed in the session, students will need to pay for a class in the next session to complete them. Only 2 additional classes are permitted for completion. (\$17 per class) If more classes are required students need to pay for the entire next session.

Lab Fees: Lab fees cover costs of individual hand tools, materials, and incidental lab usages such as solvents, gases and chemicals. All lab fees are indicated on the schedule and included in tuition cost when paid for online.

\$35 penalty will be imposed on returned checks. Most credit cards are accepted.

Refund/Cancellation Policy:

If student withdraws from class 1 week or more prior to start of the session, a refund or credit will be provided. After that date, no refunds or credits will be issued.

Workshops/1 Day Classes are non-refundable due to supply and material purchases.

Snow/Inclement Weather Days:

The MAC follows Middletown City Schools closings. If you have questions about whether or not your class is cancelled, please call or check our Facebook page.

STUDIO TIME: Students may arrive 30 minutes prior to the start of their scheduled class. Open studios are available to student members and are designed to allow artists the opportunity to work on their own in a creative environment with the necessary equipment when classes are not in session. Open studio hours are determined by class schedules. Exceptions are Jewelry Studio, Glass & Enameling. Due to use of special kilns and equipment, instructors must be present.

Our ceramics studio is available to students that are self sustaining and do not need instructor guidance. Ceramics open studio hours are posted. Students need to clean up 30 minutes prior to next class or prior to closing time.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

Students are responsible to clean their work areas after their class, which includes wiping down tables, easels, removing paint, water and pastel dust, discarding any papers, etc. and cleaning off anything left on the counters. Please leave your workspace the way you want it left for you. The MAC has the right to dispose of things not properly stored.

LOCKERS AND STORAGE AREAS:

Lockers are \$15.00/6 months or \$25.00/year. Lockers not renewed will be cleaned out 2 weeks after renewal expires. Only current works-in-progress may be stored at the MAC. Students are responsible for identifying and dating all work kept in lockers or storage areas. The MAC reserves the right to clean out unidentified or non-current work. Any work left unidentified or unattended for 60+ days will be disposed of, including reusing and/or selling materials or works of art with proceeds benefiting the MAC.

MAC classes and programs are sometimes photographed for publicity purposes, such as brochures, advertising, and other promotional material. Permission to use your and/or your child(rens') name(s) and/or photos/videos in publicity is implied by enrollment. Please contact administration in writing if you do not wish to be included in promotional materials.

COVID-19: We adhere to CDC rules in regard to COVID-19. Updates to this policy will be posted on the website.

Those who are equipped with oxygen will not be permitted to take Jewelry or Enameling classes due to equipment that is used. Service animals are welcome!
