CATEGORIES

Oil / Acrylic Watercolor Mixed Media, 2D & 3D (Note medias on form) Ceramics Fiber Arts Jewelry (Note Jewelry & title on form) Enameling (Note Enameling & title on form) Photography, Digital Art & Printmaking Drawing Glass

AWARDS

- Best of Show: \$200 cash award.
- **First Place:** Memorial scholarship to a MAC class/workshop, one per category.
- **Rookie of the Year:** Memorial scholarship to a MAC class/workshop.
- Second Place, Third Place and Honorable Mention: Ribbons.
- There must be 8 accepted pieces in a category to be judged for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd. For categories not meeting 8 piece minimum, judge(s) may elect to award Honorable Mention or Best of Show. The final decision, in all cases, rests with the judges.
- <u>ROOKIE OF THE YEAR</u>: Any beginning student working in a new medium for less than one year is considered "Rookie" status and is eligible to compete for the "Rookie of the Year" award. Must note on entry. The award is to encourage MAC students to try new mediums and to participate in the student exhibit. They will be awarded

DELIVERY OF WORK Works will be accepted: April 22—25 during regular building hours.

ELIGIBILTY

- Any student enrolled in one or more adult <u>class</u> or <u>workshop</u> at the **MAC between May 2023 through May 2024.**
- MAC annual student membership fee must be upto-date to exhibit work in the Student Exhibition.
- Entries must be current work from the period of May 2023—2024 and be representative of class/ workshop work.
- All works must be original (no prints) and **NOT exhibited previously in Main Exhibition Hall** at the MAC (i.e. MAC Area Art or Photo Exhibit).
- A maximum of (3) three, art pieces per student will be accepted. Pieces may be all from a single class, workshop or a combination thereof. (If in Jewelry and Enameling class you may submit a <u>combination</u> of 4 pieces per student that will go in the display cases, this is due to the limited space available).
- Consultation with instructors to determine best work is encouraged.
- Maximum size for <u>2D work, which includes the</u> frame, is <u>36</u>" X <u>36</u>".
- All 2-D work must be properly matted, framed and wired for hanging, with the exception of canvas works that may be unframed, but wired and ready for hanging. (No tape or saw tooth hangers allowed) The MAC reserves the right to reject any work that is not properly prepared for display.
- The MAC highly encourages pricing work for sale and retains 30% of sale price. Work that is not for sale must be marked NFS. All reasonable care will be taken in handling work submitted; however, the MAC cannot be responsible for loss, or damage to works of art. All works are entered at the artist's own risk.
- MAC reserves the right to have work photographed or videotaped for reasonable publicity purposes.
- MAC reserves the exclusive right, and sole discretion, to reject work that is not found suitable for publication or that does not meet our criteria.
- Compositions based on other artists' work must be indicated as such on the entry form.
- Entering work shall indicate agreement with these conditions.
- Work may not be removed from the exhibit until after July 3, 2024.
