Scholarship Program Criteria

What Scholarships Cover

- Tuition only for 4-, 6-, and 8-week Youth, Teen, and Adult classes
- Not included: Membership fees, lab fees, supplies, and materials

How to Apply

- Complete a scholarship application form:
- Submit applications (paper forms) to the Assistant Director- Operations, Kim Minor
 - o Submit in person at the front desk OR
 - o Submit via email to: kimminor@middletownartscenter.com
- Deadline: At least 3 weeks prior to the start of the desired session

Eligibility

- Financial need-based, determined by the MAC Board of Governors according to established parameters and at their discretion.
- Applicants must live within a 50-mile radius of the MAC
 - o Priority given to Middletown residents
- Maximum of 2 scholarships per calendar year
 - o Classes must be in separate sessions (no concurrent classes)
 - Calendar year runs January–December (Session 1 through Session 6)
- Past recipients who:
 - O Fail to attend regularly, or
 - o Withdraw without notice
 - → Will not be eligible for future assistance
- Scholarships are subject to available spots in classes (open registration). If a class is full, the student may:
 - O Elect to choose another available class, or
 - o Hold their scholarship until a space opens in a future session of the desired class.
- Scholarships are not guaranteed and depend on need and available funds

Enrollment & Funding

- Funded by the generosity of MAC donors
- The Board of Governors allocates funding each calendar year (January–December)
